

## Try It - Creped Filter Paper

Tips & Techniques using Creped Filter Paper from Stampin' Up!

1. Color and Fringe – Spray the Creped Filter Paper with a mixture of ink and alcohol. Cut the piece into fringe and apply to your project.



2. Faux Silk – Stamp a cardstock panel. Cover stamped panel with Glue Stick. Cut Creped Filter Paper larger than cardstock panel. Wrinkle filter paper up, unwrinkle and adhere to the glue covered panel. Trim edges.



3. Ruffled – Cut a strip of Creped Filter Paper, and color with ink and alcohol if desired. Stitch a running stitch along the top edge, and gather into a ruffle.



4. Cut into Flower Shapes – Color Creped Filter Paper as desired. Use die cuts to cut into flower shapes. Use Baker’s Twine, a Dahlia or Boutique Detail, a button or a brad for flower center. Add other flower shapes from DSP.



5. Stitched Pocket – Cut two identical shapes, insert confetti, sequins or other small shapes. Stitch edges together and apply to your project.



6. Stamped Images – stamp on Creped Filter Paper, die cut or trim with scissors and adhere to project with Glue Stick or acrylic sealer.
