

Try It - Watercolor Paper

Techniques using Watercolor Paper from Stampin' Up! in various ways

1. Stamp and Spritz – Stamp your images onto watercolor paper with Classic ink, and lightly spray with water using a Stampin' Spritzer.



2. Rainbow Drips or Watercolor Markers – Scribble small sections of color with several different Stampin' Write dye based markers, and spray generously with water. Let drip down the piece of watercolor paper before drying. You can also marker a whole panel before spraying for a different look.



3. Emboss Resist (line image and bold image) – Stamp image in Versamark ink, and heat emboss using either Clear or White Embossing Powder.



4. Classic Watercolor – Stamp image in Jet Black Stazon ink, and color images using reinkers and Aqua Painters.



5. Dry Emboss or Letterpress Look – Run a piece of watercolor paper through a Textured Impressions Embossing Folder with or without ink.



**Don't forget to try inking the opposite side of the embossing folder for a different pattern when possible.
